Hebrew - Shalom Used 230+ times in OT

signifies a sense of well-being and harmony both within and without; perfect completeness, wholeness, and peace—especially

As it relates to Yahweh

Peace Greek - Eirēnē Used 92 times in NT

Refers to the state of untroubled, undisturbed tranquility despite the circumstances in which we find ourselves; to bind, or weave together, the ability to hold it together no matter the state of things around us






Isaiah 53:1-6
